You will also be responsible for commodity tax advice (GST, PST) and the monthly/annual filings of tax documents including T5, NRT, FMT, BC/AB Carbon Tax. A successful candidate works well both individually and with others, is deadline driven, and can prioritize work and multitask with limited direction and supervision. This role has the potential to grow your financial accounting career into a Sr. role within Canlin.

- Help to prepare and present 11-page Revenue and Royalty Report to CFO, Controller, VP of Operations & other Sr. members of Canlin finance at Monthly Stewardship meetings. Reporting includes month-over-month variance analysis, accrual to budget reviews, hedging, volume, and pricing discussions.
- Responsible for monthly revenue and royalty accrual, including compiling, analyzing and booking accruals for Oil, C5, NGL's and SUL revenue, along with associated Crown, IOGC, ORR and NPI royalties
- Work with various subject matter experts and respond to ad-hoc stakeholder requests for performance information with regards to production volumes, transportation, product analysis, commodity price & royalty.
- Responsible for administration, implementation and continuous improvement of Royalty and Gas Cost Allowance Regimes across AB, BC and SK
- Responsible for internal tax audits (revenue and royalty) and annual commodity tax reviews
- Lead and assist in monthly/annual financial processes such as Balance Sheet Account Reconciliation, Budgeting and Forecasting,
