



Maintenance Specialist (Stationary/Mechanical) Wildcat Hills – Overview

Reporting to the Wildcat Hills Maintenance Coordinator, you will be the extension of the MRA (Maintenance, Reliability, and Automation) team. Your key accountability will be the safe and efficient repairs and preventative maintenance of rotating and stationary equipment in the Wildcat Hills District. You will be required to provide direct guidance and support to consistently meet or exceed expectations in the following areas; production, operating cost, corporate values, environment, health and safety, training, regulatory and emergency response.

Location: Cochrane, AB

Maintenance Specialist, Wildcat Hills – The Role

This is a full-time role in Cochrane, Alberta, based out of the Wildcat Hills Gas Plant and consists of a 4-day, 40-hour work week (shift subject to change). This role will primarily support the Wildcat Hills Plant and Field, and occasionally support other assets within the Wildcat Hills District. The following are key responsibilities:

- Execute scheduled preventative maintenance and repairs on both rotating equipment and stationary equipment
- Collaborate with the MRA team to enhance equipment reliability and update preventative maintenance procedures
- Demonstrate and uphold all Canlin's rules, guidelines, policies and procedures applicable to the operation
- Maintain a high level of communication on work executed with the MRA team
- Participate in continuous improvement initiatives with-in the MRA team
- Support the MRA team and Operations as a subject matter expert for MOC's and/or Projects with trade and area specific knowledge
- Promote an adaptive, and collaborative environment as a multi-faceted tradesperson.
- Support district objectives to meet Canlin's goals as a low-cost producer

- Dual Journeyman Certification in Mechanical Trade (Heavy-Duty, Millwright, etc.) and Steamfitter/Pipefitter Trade (required)
- 10+ years of maintenance/operations experience in upstream oil and gas plant or field environments preferred
- 5+ years of experience working in CMMS/EAM software preferred
- Excellent troubleshooting and Root Cause analysis skills

- Ability to motivate others in a high performing, fast-paced work environment
- Comfortable working in a sour gas processing environment and facilities
- A strong understanding and experience in upstream gas processing, and gathering system optimization will be considered an asset
- Experience or training in Waukesha and Ariel equipment
- Any Specialty training would be considered an asset (Compressor Curve software, Vibration Analysis, Oil analysis, Etc.)
- High school diploma
- Valid Class 5 driver's license
- Certification in H2S Alive, First Aid, WHIMIS, TDG
- This person will be required to meet physical demands associated with trade work (lifting up-to 50lbs, use of stairs/ladders, work outdoors in various weather conditions)
